### 1st Reading - Isaiah 43.1-7

<sup>1</sup> But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel:Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.

<sup>2</sup> When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

<sup>3</sup> For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Saviour. I give Egypt as your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in exchange for you.

<sup>4</sup> Because you are precious in my sight, and honoured, and I love you, I give people in return for you, nations in exchange for your life.

<sup>5</sup> Do not fear, for I am with you; I will bring your offspring from the east, and from the west I will gather you;

<sup>6</sup> I will say to the north, 'Give them up', and to the south, 'Do not withhold; bring my sons from far away and my daughters from the end of the earth—

<sup>7</sup> everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made.'

## Psalm 29

<sup>1</sup> Ascribe to the Lord, you powers of heaven: ascribe to the Lord glory and might.

<sup>2</sup> Ascribe to the Lord the honour due to his name: **O worship the Lord in the beauty of his holiness.** 

<sup>3</sup> The voice of the Lord is upon the waters: **the God of glory thunders**, **the Lord upon the great waters**.

<sup>4</sup> The voice of the Lord is mighty in operation: the voice of the Lord is a glorious voice.

- <sup>5</sup> The voice of the Lord breaks the cedar-trees: the Lord breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.
- <sup>6</sup> He makes them skip like a calf: Lebanon and Sirion like a young wild ox.
- <sup>7</sup> The voice of the Lord divides the lightning-flash: the voice of the Lord whirls the sands of the desert, the Lord whirls the desert of Kadesh.

<sup>8</sup> The voice of the Lord rends the terebinth trees, and strips bare the forests: in his temple all cry 'Glory.'

<sup>9</sup> The Lord sits enthroned above the water-flood: the Lord sits enthroned as a king for ever.

<sup>10</sup> The Lord will give strength to his people: the Lord will give to his people the blessing of peace.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Acts 8.14-17

<sup>14</sup> Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them. <sup>15</sup> The two went down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit <sup>16</sup> (for as yet the Spirit had not come upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus). <sup>17</sup> Then Peter and John laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

### The Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke 3.15-22, Glory to you Lord Jesus Christ

<sup>15</sup> As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah,<sup>16</sup> John answered all of them by saying, 'I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. <sup>17</sup> His winnowing-fork is in his hand, to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his granary; but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire.' <sup>18</sup> So, with many other exhortations, he proclaimed the good news to the people. <sup>19</sup> But Herod the ruler, who had been rebuked by him because of Herodias, his brother's wife, and because of all the evil things that Herod had done, <sup>20</sup> added to them all by shutting up John in prison. <sup>21</sup> Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, <sup>22</sup> and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.'
