**1<sup>st</sup> Reading - Isaiah 50.4-9a**

<sup>4</sup> The Lord God has given me the tongue of a teacher, that I may know how to sustain the weary with a word. Morning by morning he wakens—wakens my ear to listen as those who are taught.

<sup>5</sup> The Lord God has opened my ear, and I was not rebellious, I did not turn backwards.

<sup>6</sup> I gave my back to those who struck me, and my cheeks to those who pulled out the beard; I did not hide my face from insult and spitting.

<sup>7</sup> The Lord God helps me; therefore I have not been disgraced; therefore I have set my face like flint, and I know that I shall not be put to shame;

<sup>8</sup> he who vindicates me is near. Who will contend with me? Let us stand up together. Who are my adversaries? Let them confront me.

<sup>9</sup> It is the Lord God who helps me; who will declare me guilty? All of them will wear out like a garment; the moth will eat them up.

<sup>9</sup> Have mercy upon me, O Lord, for I am in trouble: **my eye wastes away for grief, my throat also and my inward parts.**

<sup>10</sup> For my life wears out in sorrow, and my years with sighing: **my strength fails me in my affliction, and my bones are consumed.**

<sup>11</sup> I am become the scorn of all my enemies: **and my neighbours wag their heads in derision.**

<sup>12</sup> I am a thing of horror to my friends: **and those that see me in the street shrink from me.**

<sup>13</sup> I am forgotten like one dead and out of mind: **I have become like a broken vessel.**

<sup>14</sup> For I hear the whispering of many: **and fear is on every side;**

<sup>15</sup> While they plot together against me: **and scheme to take away my life.**

<sup>16</sup> But in you, Lord, have I put my trust: **I have said 'You are my God.'**

<sup>17</sup> All my days are in your hand: **O deliver me from the power of my enemies and from my persecutors.**

<sup>18</sup> Make your face to shine upon your servant: **and save me for your mercy's sake.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading - Philippians 2.5-11**

<sup>5</sup> Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,

<sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited,

<sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form,

<sup>8</sup> he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross.

<sup>9</sup> Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name,

<sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

<sup>11</sup> and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
